## Summary of topics discussed:

- 1. **TARC Membership Application** All updates have been completed and the new membership application is available on the TARC website and in the latest issue of The Communicator.
- 2. Winter Field Day Winter Field Day was held on January 25 & 26. The antennas went up and the radios worked well. The people who participated had fun. Earlier communications at TARC meetings, in The Communicator, and on Groups.io regarding events may increase participation. Jim KJ4NDO will work on a plan to encourage more members to participate at future events. The Board will propose at the next TARC meeting purchasing mementos for special events like Field Day to encourage participation.
- 3. **Megalodon Weekend** The Board approved participating in Megalodon Weekend on March 7 & 8. Steve NS4P will be the Event Coordinator and will communicate with Karen to get the final course route and communicate it to the club. The DMR local 9 repeater will be used. Some members have extra DMR radios that will be available for use for this event. This is a fun event with free shirts, food, and coffee for the participants.
- 4. Shark Tooth Festival Paperwork has been sent to the organizers of the event with a special request for the TARC location to be the same as last year. Voice, CW, and Satellite will be available at the tent location while FT8 will be done at the member's QTH. Jim and Frank W2XYZ will work on the sign-up sheet which will include a Greeter column. The Greeter will provide a short introduction as to what TARC does.
